

BORROWING RULES

- Books can be borrowed only upon producing the Institute Identity Card.
- Users should check the book thoroughly for missing pages, chapters, underlines, etc., at the time
 of issue counter.
- Books will not be accepted in damaged or mutilated condition from the user at the time of return.
- In case of loss of books, the borrower is required to replace the book with a recent edition
- If the book is not available anywhere for purchase, the borrower must pay triple the cost of the volume / document.
- Books borrowed by a user should be brought to library only for returning purpose.
- DVDs/CDs cannot be borrowed by the library users.
- Users can't borrow a book on others ID card, such action is punishable.
- Books from Circulation Section are issued to all eligible members as per their entitlements.
- Reference Books / Materials such as encyclopedias, dictionaries, handbooks etc., are not issued outside the library.
