



Guidelines for Expert Talk Series (ETS) -URR24

As per the URR24 scheme of instructions, all the students of B. Tech. I-Semester have to attend Expert Lectures / Talks, which will be delivered by industry experts / eminent persons in the fields related to engineering education. Expert Talk Series (ETS) is a mandatory course in the first six semesters. In connection with ETS, the following guidelines are issued to students:

- (i) The Head of the Department (HoD) concerned will be appointing section wise & department level ETS coordinators. The department ETS coordinator in consultation with the institute level ETS coordinator (Head, Centre for I²RE) will be overseeing the activities. Hence students will have to communicate with section wise ETS coordinator for any related issues.
- (ii) Students shall note that ETS is a mandatory one credit semester long course.
- (iii) Each expert talk shall be for a minimum duration of 45 minutes (but not exceeding 90 minutes) followed by online quiz/test for 10 marks (10 MCQs/FiBs ; duration: 10-15 mins), on the contents covered in the expert talk.
- (iv) The Head C-i2RE shall share the marks obtained by the students in each of the quizzes / tests to the respective department ETS coordinators
- (v) Each student shall attend a minimum of 6 expert talks and attempt the corresponding quizzes/ tests conducted at the end of the talks.
- (vi) Students will have to maintain ETS Record Book (a 100 page long notebook). Students are advised to take notes from the expert talks organized under ETS. (mention date and time of each lecture)
- (vii) There shall be only continuous Internal Evaluation (CIE) for ETS for a maximum of 100 marks, which include marks for attending ETS sessions, marks obtained by attempting quiz papers after each talk and marks for submitting report in standard format.

- (viii) The ETSfaculty coordinator will submit the final marks of the allotted students in week (N+1)
- (ix) For further clarifications / concerns students are advised to consult ETS coordinator or concerned HoD
