Note:

- 1. Students should join ETS online using MS Teams (link shall be shared through domain email) credentials at least 10 minutes before start of the talk.
- 2. Expert talk is followed by a 10 minute online quiz/test consisting of 10 multiple-choice or fill-in-the-blank questions covering the session's content.
- 3. Students are required to maintain a 100-page ETS NOTEBOOK to record their learnings. At the end of the semester, a report on the acquired learnings must be submitted for evaluation.
- 4. Evaluation criteria include quiz scores (10 marks per quiz), attendance (20 marks), and the final report (20 marks).
