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Dear Students

As part of URR-24 curriculum, Expert Talk Series (ETS) was introduced in URR-24 to provide you with valuable exposure to real-world industry scenarios, bridging the gap between academic learning and the skills required by the industry. This initiative also helps in enhancing your employability-related skills.

A. Important Points:

- Maintain a separate notebook for Expert Talk Series course
- It is essential to **attend all 10 Expert Talk sessions** to maximize your attendance marks.
- **Key Points of the Expert Talk: Write running notes with key points** in your ETS notebook for each session as you have to take a quiz immediately after every session.
- **Submit your ETS notebook to your faculty counselor, during the weekly MYC interactions,** for verification and signature.
- **At the end of semester you have to submit your ETS notebook** to your Faculty Counselor after completing all 10 sessions for assessment.
- Your Faculty Counselor will assess and communicate your marks to ETS faculty coordinator
- After the assessment, you will receive your ETS notebook back.
- **Keep the ETS notebook in a safe place,** as they will become a valuable resource over time. You will realize their importance at the appropriate time and can refer to them as needed in the future.

B. Answer following 2 questions, after every session in your ETS notebook

In addition to writing key points of expert talk, you have to answer the following two (2) questions in your ETS notebook. Each Expert Talk session will be assessed for a total of **2 marks**.

Q1 : Key Learnings: What are the three most important points from the expert talk that resonated with you the most and WHY? **(1 mark)**

Q2 : Practical application: How do you plan to apply your learning from the expert talk in your personal or professional life? **(1 mark)**

C. Evaluation of ETS:

The evaluation for ETS will be for 100 marks based on the following components (CIE as per URR-24):

1. Attendance (20 Marks):

- Attend all sessions
- Attendance for all 10 Expert Talk sessions will be recorded.
- You will receive **2 marks per session**, contributing a total of **20 marks** for your attendance in all 10 sessions.

2. Quiz Score (60 Marks):

- You have to take quiz, immediately after each ETS session
- Each quiz will be evaluated for 10 marks
- Out of the 10 quizzes or tests, your **best 6 scores** will be considered.
- Sum of your best 6 scores will contribute a total of **60 marks**.

3. Report - ETS Notebook (20 marks)

- You are required to maintain separate notebook for the Expert Talk Series
- Write running notes, as you have to take quiz immediately and record your learning's from each session for each Expert Talk and show it to your faculty counselor during weekly MYC interaction and take his signature.
- Your faculty counselor, after evaluating your ETS notebook will award marks out of 20
