The Government of India has initiated a plan to boost the Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises (MSMEs) with Technology and Artificial Intelligence through continuous innovation and to build adequate support infrastructure to nourish such innovations through Business Incubators (BIs) through Host Institutes/organizations. Businesses Incubators (BIs) are also required for assisting in commercialization of such ideas there by accelerate such Technologies from ideas to successful business and generate employment opportunities. The Business Incubators (BIs) for enabling the MSMEs to develop innovative Ideas that is not only useful for MSMEs but also for the complete industrial ecosystem. Institutions such as Technical Colleges, Universities, other Professional Colleges/Institutes, R&D Institutes NGOs involved in relevant activities, Entrepreneurs Development Centre (DCs) MSME-Dis/Technology Centers (TCs). DICs or any Institute/Organization of Central/ state Government may apply for Host Institute and set up a Business Incubator.

Grant in Aid support will be provided to approved Host Institutes (HIs) for incubation related defined activities. Also Host Institutes shall be provided grant up to `1.00 Crore for procurement and installation of relevant plant and machines including hardware and software etc. in Business Incubator.

Based on the importance, the Institute has submitted a proposal to the Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, Government of India, New Delhi on 18.12.2019 to recognize this Institute to be a host Institute for implementation of the scheme "Support for Entrepreneurial and Managerial Development of MSMEs through Business Incubator. After careful consideration of the proposal submitted by the Institute the Director, Ministry of Micro, Small & Medium Enterprises, Government of India, New Delhi vide its letter F.No. 3(10)Inc/7th PMAC/2020-21 dated15.04.2021 has communicated that the proposal of Our Institute has been considered and approved during its meeting of Project Monitoring and Advisory Committee (PMAC) held at New Delhi on 25.03.2021 and also further requested to upload undertaking duly signed so as to enable the Intitute to become eligible to submit new innovative idea for getting financial support under the scheme as per the guidelines. We have uploaded the signed undertaking on 19.04.2021. The minutes of meeting of PMAC and our Institute's undertaking are appended herewith.
