Sub: Warangal Commissionerate-Formation of Anti-Drug Committees (ADCs) in all educational institutions across the Commissionerate-Instructions-Regarding.

You all aware that the Government of Telangana has constituted Telangana State Anti-Narcotics Bureau (TSNAB) to combat drug trafficking including cultivation, production, transportation, smuggling, sale, purchase, possession or consumption of narcotics and psychotropic substances.


In this regard, specific instructions have been issued for creation of Anti-drug committees in all the educational institutions and to monitoring it for the proper function of its activities. The same has also been circulated to TS Board of Intermediate, Department of Technical Education and Higher Education.

Therefore, all the ACsP, CIs and SHOs are instructed to take immediate steps in formation of Anti-Drug committees in all the educational institutions of your respective jurisdiction by consulting with the Heads of Institutions, see that the functioning of such committees started by following the guidelines incorporated in the circular and out of them, the following important instructions must followed.

- The committee must consists at least 5 members headed by the Head of Institution and must be involving representatives of civil, police and NGOs.
- The warning hoardings must be placed within the premises of institutions contains the seriousness of Act and punishments. Also institutions shall give vide publicity through various means about laws relating to drugs.
- While commencing every academic year, the Head of Institution should arrange meeting with various functionaries/agents, hostel wardens, representatives of student unions, parents/guardians, faculty and should discuss all possible measures to be taken to prevent drugs because it becomes danger and spoiling the life of youth particularly students.
- SHOs should identify the persons those indulging and abetting drugs peddling/consumption and immediate steps to be taken legally by booking them under appropriate sections.
- The committee should conduct events like Anti-Drugs work shop, counseling, awareness programmes educating ill effects of drugs.
- It is the responsibility of the committees that whether they noticed any such things or particular students indulging in consumption or possession of drugs, they should intimate local police immediately and Help line No. **8712671111 & Email.ID: tsnabho-hyd@tspolice.gov.in.**
- You are specifically instructed to conduct meetings with Principals/Correspondents/HODs of the educational institutions under your limits periodically to enlighten the importance of awareness on substance use and illicit trafficking.

All the ACsP/SHOs/CIs should treat this as top priority, take steps for immediate formation /creation of Anti-Drug committees and monitor the functioning. They are further instructed to conduct awareness programs in their respective jurisdiction and inform about each awareness program to CSB Warangal to maintain record and to forward it to the state Anti-Narcotics Bureau.
