The meeting commenced at 11:00 am and was presided over by the chairman of the Anti-Drug Committee. At the outset, the chairman & principal welcomed the members to the meeting to discuss the pre-notified items on the agenda.

Resolutions:-

- Dr. Jagadish Babu, senior neuro psychiatrist explained about various drugs which are used in the society. Few of them include:
 - 1) Nicotin 2) Alcohol 3) Ganja/Kannabis 4) LSD 5) Opium etc.
- Most of them are called by tricky names.
- Most of them are treated as alcoholic addiction so that image of institute/individual is not tarnished.
- Addictions of Kannabis can be identified by bloodshot eyes/sleepy eyes.
- Reasons for drugs consumption are 1) Peer pressure 2) over individuality 3) Lower social source etc.
- Drug consumption is increasing in the society every year.

The following resolutions are taken unanimously. Based on the above inputs, the following preventive measures are to be taken to curb the drug activities in the college.

- 1) Awareness is to be created among the students about the consequences of usage of drugs through the institute website, displaying the posters at the important places of the institute.
- 2) Periodic check is to be done by the chief warden/warden in the hostel rooms.

- 3) If a person is anticipated in consuming drugs, his details are to be kept confidential and is to be directed to the counselor or psychiatrist for further counseling.
- 4) Counseling of the student is always to be done in the presence of the parent only.
- 5) Motivate the faculty, staff and students to be a drug free campus.
- 6) Seminars are to be arranged by the concerned officials to create awareness among the students to curb the drug activities.
- 7) Awareness is to be created among the students about NDPS Act, 1985 consequences and punishment as suggested by Sri Raj Kumar Gani, Sub-inspector of Police, KV Police station.
- 8) Information is to be given to the students to watch "SANJU", a Bollywood movie came in 2018 about the consequences of drug addiction and how to come out of that to lead a good normal life in the society.
