

The coordinator, IQAC appraised on pre-notified agenda items related to mandatory academic activities of AY 2021-22. The committee deliberated issues at length regarding upholding the quality of Teaching- Learning process, quality of assessment and integrity of examination process.

Resolution No. 2022-IQAC5-R1:

The Internal Quality Assurance Cell (IQAC) noted the details of IQAC – 4th meeting which was held on 23.01.2021.

Appraisal on Conduction of online/Physical classes and examinations for UG
& PG students during the ongoing COVID-19 Pandemic

As per the guidelines of UGC / AICTE, the new A.Y. 2020-21 started on August 03, 2020 online classes through Microsoft Teams. The MSE-1 conducted for MBA III semester and B.Tech. III, V, VI semester from September 09, 2020.

In between, as per the guidelines *stipulated by UGC/AICTE*, we conducted End Semester Examination (ESE) of even semester of A.Y. 2019-20 from October 09, 2020. Due to severity of ongoing COVID-19 pandemic, the institute AAC has decided to conduct virtually invigilated / proctored online exams.

The teaching – learning process for the odd sem of A.Y. 2020-21 started from 03.08.2020 as per Almanac. MSE-II started for MBA III semester and B.Tech. III, V, VI semester from December 14, 2020 as per almanac. ESE for the odd semester of A.Y. 2020-21 was conducted for MBA III semester students from December 24, 2020 and B.Tech. III, V, VI semester students conducted from January 05, 2021.

Mandatory induction programme of B.Tech. I semester students started from December 02, 2020 as per guidelines issued by UGC / AICTE / and MSE-I was conducted from January 18, 2021. Started online classes to first year PG on January 07, 2021. B.Tech. even semester classes for A.Y. 2020-21 started from 07 February 2021 as per the almanac, via online mode. Now, the institute AAC has decided to conduct staggered laboratory classes in physical mode, exams in physical mode and physical mode classes to all PG students.

March, 2021

- The State government has resolved to take steps to reopen the colleges from February 1, 2021 following strict COVID-19 protocols. In this connection, staggered laboratory classes for B.Tech have been conducted.
- At the same time, physical mode of classes has been conducted for all M.Tech & MBA first semester students from March 01, 2021.

- After that, we conducted staggered offline examinations for MSEs and ESEs to PG students.
- Conduction of Laboratory Classes in Physical Mode for B.Tech First Semester Students from March 03, 2021 to March 13, 2021.
- End semester examinations (ESE) For B.Tech I semester has been conducted from 07-03-2021.
- As per the recommendations and resolutions in academic advisory committee (AAC) meeting, it has been decided to conduct staggered laboratory classes in physical mode for all semesters of B.Tech programmes to give hands on lab experience to the students.

April, 2021

- As per the G.O received from Govt. of Telangana, in view of COVID-19, our institute Kakatiya Institute of Technology and Science, Warangal suspended physical mode of classwork with immediate effect.
- In view of this, the institute's AAC decided to conduct classes through online mode for the II semester
 of B.Tech Programme for the A.Y. 2020-21 from April 19, 2021 (Monday).

May, 2021

- For IV, VI and VIII semesters of B.Tech Programme, Online Laboratory Classes, CIE and ESE Evaluation has continued to progress the A.Y. 2021-22.
- Mini Project, Major Project Dissertation work for M.Tech. Programme and MBA viva voce has been conducted from 1st May, 2021 to 02nd June 2021.
- The II semester class work for M.Tech/MBA Programme of A.Y. 2020-21 have commenced on May17, 2021 (Monday) and the classes were conducted in online mode.

June. 2021

The results of B.Tech (I Semester) for A.Y. 2020-21 were declared on 29.06.2021.

August, 2021

- During the period of 19.8.2021 23.08.2021, B.Tech (IV, VI & VIII semester) & PG (odd semester) semester results were declared batch wise.
- Advanced supplementary examinations for B.Tech (I to VII) semesters were conducted in August, 2021.

The coordinator, IQAC appraised on online & Physical classes conducting for UG & PG students of AY 2020-21. In view of the Covid-19 pandemic and subsequent nationwide/statewide guidelines, the institute followed conduction of online & physical classes for UG & PG students, online & Physical assessment of mid examinations for UG & PG students of B.Tech. 
